Complex Reoperative Surgery

Our team offers solid experience with complex surgical procedures for complicated benign and malignant conditions. Our surgeons have expertise in reoperative surgery in the abdomen and pelvis for various indications.

Continence Preservation & Ostomy Avoidance

Our surgeons use advanced techniques to help preserve continence and avoid an ostomy over the short and long-term, even in patients with complex colorectal disease conditions, after multiple previous operations and complicated disease or surgery.

Minimally Invasive & Robotic Surgery

Our surgeons routinely employ minimally invasive methods including laparoscopic, robotic, transrectal and endoscopic techniques for a variety of colorectal conditions.

Colorectal Polyps & Cancer

Our surgeons have expertise in the comprehensive management of early and advanced polyps and cancer with the use of advanced technologies such as robotic surgery and transanal endoscopic microsurgery (TEMS). Additionally, our surgeons have specialized knowledge in techniques that can help to avoid permanent ostomy, even in cases of advanced, recurrent, rare or complex cancers.

Pelvic Floor Care
